IMPORTANT SAFETY MEASURES:

- Farmers need to make safety and security their number 1 priority.
- If you allow any person or worker on your farm or in and around your house, always do a thorough vetting of this person or worker.
- Ensure that you have a valid identification of the person – a valid identity document.
- Have fingerprints taken.
- Request proof of the physical home address and all contact numbers of the person.
- Make the necessary reference calls to verify the person's background if possible.
- It is essential to heed the advice of security organisations who do the groundwork in their specific areas.
- Place as many obstacles as possible between you and the intruder:
 - Electric fence.
 - Electric gate.
 - Guard dogs.
 - Burglar bars and security gates.
 - Alarms and beams.
 - Cameras.
 - Panic buttons.
 - 2-Way radios.
- Every household should be connected to their area's emergency platforms 24/7.
- Form part and be available on WhatsApp groups, and any other organised anti-crime group in your area.
- The more time an invader has to spend to reach you to overcome the many obstacles in his way, the longer time you will have to ask for help.
- This is very important because of the rural areas and the distances between farms.
- Areas with poor reception face even more challenges.
- Contact your service provider and resolve the matter.
- Do not make obvious mistakes:
 - Ensure that cell phone batteries are always full and in working order.
 - Ensure you always have enough data.
- Electricity shortages and loadshedding wreak havoc on electrical security systems, batteries, and the batteries of backups.
 - Always ensure that security systems and backup batteries are fully charged in case of an outage.
- Invest in as much solar power as possible on your electrical fence, gate and other security electronics.
- Ensure that you have a backup system with a 110-amp battery.

- There are many safety and security solutions available, for instance, panic buttons.
 - Do not entertain any cash transactions on your property.
 - Extra cash on the premises can be a danger.
 - Do not pay salaries or wages in cash.
 - Keep any and all valuables out of sight and locked away.
 - Store all weapons and ammunition safely.
 - Daily routines:
 - Change your daily routines as much as possible and consider whether you need to stop at your gate before entering, which gate you use and at what time.
 - Make these changes to every aspect of your daily life and your family's home life.
 - The less predictable your routine is to outsiders – the more difficult it is for them to plan an attack.
 - Use only one door when going in and out of the house.
 - Keep the rest of the doors leading to the outside locked and bolted.
 - Ensure that there are appropriate security bars in front of all the windows and sliding doors.
 - Do not sit in the front garden and leave the back door wide open.
 - Keep all family, guests and children aware of your situation and ensure they are also mindful of security measures and potential danger.
 - When your dogs bark, do not shout at the dogs to keep quiet.
 - Always do a thorough inspection into the reason why the dogs were barking and praise them for their commitment and surveillance.
 - There have been incidents of dogs barking whilst perpetrators sit on the outskirts looking in.
 - Other incidents show meat and bones being thrown to dogs, in an attempt to have the dogs submit.
 - Perpetrators have been known to urinate through fences and give dogs treats in an effort to familiarise the dogs with them and have the dogs comply.
 - Perpetrators will do anything and will even poison barking dogs.
