LEGAL RAMIFICATIONS
AND POTENTIAL MISUSE

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS:

• DEFAMATION:

 - The victim who receives these messages feels increasingly anxious and unsafe owing to the threatening emojis.
 - However, when she decides to report the harassment to her supervisor and the human resources department, they struggle to fully comprehend the gravity of the situation.
 - Lacking an understanding of emoji nuances, they may dismiss the victim's concerns or fail to grasp the true malicious intent behind the messages.
 - The actual severity of the situation could be downplayed, impacting the victim's emotional well-being and potentially leaving employers liable for neglecting her safety and mental health.
- Emojis undoubtedly enhance the expression of our digital communication.
- Nevertheless, their potential misuse can lead to severe consequences, especially in cases involving defamation, harassment, discrimination, and hate speech.

• Given the complexity and subjectivity of emoji interpretation, it is crucial to exercise caution in their usage, significantly when emotions are heightened or when addressing sensitive topics.
