ONLINE SCAMS SURGE AMID THE SOUTH AFRICAN FINANCIAL CHALLENGES.

THIS IS AN URGENT CALL FOR VIGILANCE AND RISK ANALYSIS.

PUPPY SCAMMING CRIMINAL AKA CHARLES OLSEN



A concerning surge in scams has plagued our vulnerable and trusting society.

South Africans, already grappling with the financial challenges affecting our nation and the world, find themselves under siege from cunning criminals. - The advertisement conveniently provided a WhatsApp contact, leading our client to Charles Olsen, who claimed to be a reputable dog "breeder."
- Engaging in a WhatsApp conversation, our client agreed to purchase the Maltese Poodle from Charles Olsen for R5,900.00, with the understanding that CenterPoint Logistics, a well-known transport service, would handle the safe delivery of the puppy to our client's location.
- Initially, Charles Olsen assured our client that the puppy would be dispatched the very next day.
- Things took an unexpected turn when our client received a call from someone named Martin Murray the following day.
- Martin Murray alleged a problem with the transportation crate and requested an additional fee of R11,000.00 to rectify the situation.
- This fee was later reduced to R6,000.00, but the puppy's shipment hinged on the funds being cleared, causing a two-day delay.
- Charles Olsen employed emotional manipulation tactics designed to sow confusion, leading our client to make substantial payments.
- This is a common tactic seen in such scams, where fraudsters begin with small amounts and then progressively increase the demands, capitalising on the victim's emotional attachment to the puppy and their fear of losing the money already invested.
- Ultimately, this cunning strategy results in the victim being persistently drained of their financial resources.
- The scammers cunningly managed to deceive our client into parting with a staggering sum of over R200,000.00 during the course of this fraudulent scheme.

UNRAVELING THE "CHARLES SENIOR" PUPPY SCAM:

In the criminal world of online scams, a particularly heartless scheme preys on individuals seeking adorable four-legged companions. This particular deceitful operation is primarily orchestrated by two individuals, whom we will refer to as "Charles Jr." and "Charles Sr."

For the sake of illustration, we will describe their deceptive tactics and how they lure unsuspecting victims into their web of deceit.

• The Scammers and Their Setup:

- Charles Jr. poses as "Martin Murray," the CEO of a fictitious company called "Centre Point Logistics."
- Meanwhile, Charles Sr., under the pseudonym "Charles Olsen," masquerades as a dog breeder.
- They operate from Rustenburg but falsely claim to be based in Queenstown and an Eastern Cape farm, respectively.

Initial Contact and Deceptive Advertising:

- Armed with a counterfeit Centre Point Logistics website and social media ads, the scammers encourage potential victims to contact them via an instant WhatsApp button placed on their advertisements.
- People searching for puppies respond to these ads, unwittingly entering the scammers' trap.

The Deceptive Sales Pitch:

 Charles Sr. skilfully convinces the victim that he is a reputable dog breeder, employing charisma to encourage the purchase of a puppy from him.

Introduction of "Centre Point Logistics":

 Once the victim agrees to buy the puppy, Charles Sr. refers them to Centre Point Logistics to handle courier services for puppy delivery.

The Transport Crate Scam:

- Charles Jr. contacts the victim the next day, claiming a problem: there is no crate available to transport the puppy.
- He states that Charles Olsen is unavailable and unreachable.
- The victim is pressured into buying or renting a crate from the courier company at an initial cost of R11,000.00, later reduced to R6,000.00.
- With manipulation and urgency tactics, the victim is coerced into making the payment.

• False Promises and Paperwork Drama:

- When Charles Olsen re-establishes contact, he apologises for his absence and promises to resolve the situation.
- However, Charles Jr. from Centre Point Logistics claims that the puppy is now stuck at Durban Airport and requires papers, including mandatory inoculations.
- To avoid this paperwork, they demanded an additional R17,000.00 from the victim.

A Complex Web of Deceit:

- The scammers manipulate the victim with distressing pictures of crates and puppies, leaving the victim feeling trapped.
- The victim is coerced into providing additional and significant sums of money, convinced they will eventually receive a refund.

• Escalation of the Scam:

- In subsequent phases, the scammers persuade the victim to pay for various additional costs, further entangling them in their web of deception.
- These include:
 - CITY & LEGAL CONTROL PERMIT: R13,560.00.
 - CATEGORY A PERMIT 6 MONTHS: R25,511.00.
 - LEGAL VIABILITY CONTROL PERMIT: R29,000.00.
 - CENTRE FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION: R25,650.00.
 - LEGAL AUTHORITIES FOR ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE: R30,000.00.
 - PUPPY INSURANCE: R74,000.00.
 - LEGAL COSTS: R109,000.00.
- As the victim becomes increasingly desperate to resolve the situation and retrieve their supposed puppy, the scammers persistently demand exorbitant fees.
- The scammers' relentless pursuit of funds only adds to the victim's emotional and financial distress, trapping them further in this heartless scam.

Introducing the Fake Lawyer:

- Charles Sr. introduces a fabricated lawyer who is supposedly involved in recovering the money from Centre Point Logistics.
- This fake lawyer threatens legal action against the scammers.

Relentless Pursuit of Funds:

- Depending on how convinced the victim is, the scammers continue to extract more money from them.
- This is the point at which our client sought our assistance.

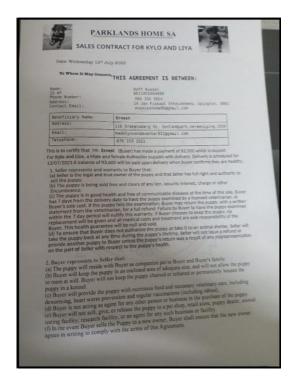

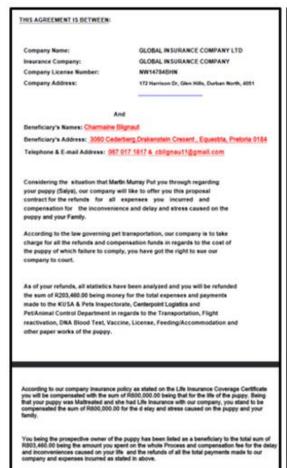

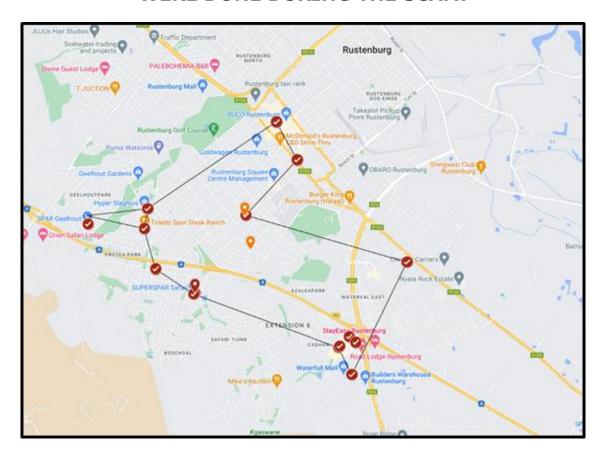

THE SCAMMERS' IDENTITIES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED.

PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES:

- Buy a pet in your immediate area, where you can safely view the pet beforehand.
- If necessary, take a friend with you when meeting the breeder.
- Undergo the appropriate home check to make sure you are a suitable owner and for you to view the puppy in its environment and how it interacts with the rest of the litter.
- Rather, adopt a puppy/dog that is already vet-checked, vaccinated, dewormed, sterilised and microchipped.
- Buy from registered breeders who belong to reputable organisations.
 - You can find responsible dog breeders by asking for referrals from your veterinarian or trusted friends,

contacting local breed clubs, or visiting professional dog shows.

- Take the photo of the pet advertised online and Google it to search whether the same picture has been used before or on different websites.
- It is also possible to take the description of the pet and do a search.
- Look at the price if it is too good to be true, it is not true!
 - Scammers sometimes advertise purebred animals for a much lower amount.
- Read through the posts on the Facebook page: Puppy Scams in South Africa and avoid falling for the same scams by the same people.
- Use existing websites like PetScams.com, which warn the public of such bogus sites.
- Do the right thing and report the fake website.
- The scammer may send you a picture of their ID as a show of legitimacy.
 - They are highly likely sending you the ID of someone who has been scammed by them before – using identity theft to perpetuate their scam.
 - Never send them your ID, as it may be used to scam someone else in the future.

It is important to understand that the puppy you have fallen in love with, does not exist.

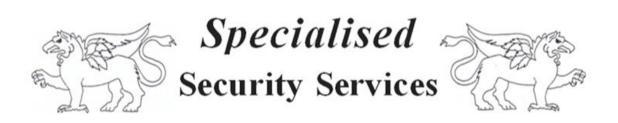
