- Once they determine the value of the prisoner, they will coerce them to transfer money into various accounts.
- The prisoners are threatened with physical harm or harm to their families, which the criminals would have researched and on which they would have obtained details.
- The harm inflicted on prisoners and their families can be severe, ranging from assault to gang rape or murder.
- Criminals can also transfer the money to overseas accounts, making it extremely difficult to trace the funds.
- These syndicates operate both inside and outside the prison system and often use private investigators to intimidate the families of the prisoners.
