

PROJECT: RHINO POACHING AND THE LAW

There are 2 species of rhino found in South Africa: the White rhino and the Black rhino.

Almost 50% of the total black rhino population is located in South Africa, whereas South Africa boasts of having the largest population of white rhinos.

Black rhinos are a critically endangered species, and it is estimated that only about 2,000 black rhinos are left in South Africa while white rhinos are classified as near threatened.

Today, there are about 27,000 rhinos left in the world.

Since 1977, there has been an international ban on rhino horn trading, but it continues to fetch huge profits on the black market, and therefore, poaching still exists.

REASONS FOR THE POACHING OF RHINOS:

- Rhinos are killed for the demand of their horns.
- The consumer demand for Rhino horn is primarily from Asian countries like China and Vietnam.
- These Rhino horns are used for traditional Chinese medicine, although it is also increasingly used as a status symbol to display success and wealth.
- Rhino horn is an extremely valuable commodity on the black market, and in weight, it is more valuable than gold, platinum or diamonds.
- Owing to the demand for horns on the black market, rhinos are constantly at risk of poaching, and very few survive outside national parks and reserves.
- African parks are creating safe havens for rhinos by securing national parks and protected areas where they live.

MEASURES IMPLEMENTED BY THE AUTHORITIES TO STOP THE POACHING OF RHINOS:

Almost all rhinos in South Africa are in national parks and private reserves, and the following strategies were put in place to secure rhinos:

- South African National Parks and privately owned reserves in South Africa de-horn their rhinos to deter the poaching of these animals.
- Anti-poaching units on the ground monitor these endangered animals.
- Rhinos are fitted with tracking devices.
- Educational drives to educate communities.

THE CRIMINALS POACHING RHINOS:

- Large criminal syndicates control the poaching of rhinos.
- These syndicates operate as well-organised groups and very often have an ex-military background.
- They also rely on the help of local poachers.

SENTENCES FOR POACHING RHINOS IN SOUTH AFRICA:

- For the past few years, hefty sentences were handed out to convicted poachers in South Africa.
- These sentences ranged between 16- and 53-years imprisonment for poaching, and it should send a stern warning to all criminals that our courts will not tolerate crimes of this nature.
- Unfortunately, many poachers get away and are never prosecuted.
- The number of rhinos that were killed for their horns in South Africa for the period 1 January 2023 to 30 June 2023 has decreased.
- This can be attributed to the fact that the authorities increased their efforts to tackle poaching.

THE IMPORTANCE OF THE CONSERVATION OF RHINOS:

- Rhino plays a critical role in maintaining the structure of the ecological community.
- Rhinos are important grazers consuming large amounts of vegetation, which helps to shape landscapes and helps other species that share their habitat.
