

# PROJECT: PREPARE YOUR FAMILY FOR EMERGENCIES

Specialised Security Services' aim is to safeguard the public as much as possible against possible criminal activities.

Therefore, taking the necessary safety measures and living with positive paranoia is crucial.

We continue to establish safety ground rules, which are extremely useful when a spouse, child or relative goes missing, is kidnapped or is incapacitated.

As we go about our daily lives, we often do not think about the possibility of an emergency occurring. However, it is critical to be prepared in case something DOES happen.

One way to do this is by sharing your personal information (passwords included) with a trusted relative or spouse.

Here are some reasons why it is important to do so:

- In case of an emergency:
  - If you are ever in an accident or become incapacitated, your loved ones will be able to access your information and make important decisions on your behalf.
  - This can include medical decisions, financial decisions, and more.
- To prevent identity theft:
  - If you pass away, your loved ones will need to take care of your estate.
  - Having access to your information can help them do this more easily and prevent identity theft.
- To locate you in case of an emergency:
  - If you ever go missing or are kidnapped, your loved ones will be able to use your information to locate you more easily.
  - This can include your phone's GPS location, your email account, etc.

Here are some steps you can take to share your information with a trusted relative or spouse:

- Create a list of important information:
  - This can include your full name, date of birth, ID number, driver's license number, passport number, etc.
- Create a list of important contacts:
  - This can include your doctor, lawyer, accountant, executor, location of where the last will and testament is kept, as well as contact details of the institution.
- Create a list of important accounts: This can include your bank accounts, investment accounts, email accounts, and more.
- Store this information in a secure location:
  - You can use a password manager or a physical safe to store this information.
  - Make sure to share the password or combination with your trusted relative or spouse.

# Remember to keep this information up-to-date and to review it regularly with your loved ones.

In addition to sharing your information with a trusted relative or spouse, you can also use the built-in tracker on your Android/IOS device or third-party apps that provide safe tracking services.

Here is a guide on how to activate and use the built-in tracker on your Android device, as well as some third-party apps that provide safe tracking services:

# How To Use "Find My Device" on Android

- 1. Open the **Settings** app on your Android device.
- 2. Scroll down and tap on **Google**.
- 3. Tap on **Security**.
- 4. Tap on Find My Device.
- 5. Toggle the switch to turn it on.
- It will be essential to write down and remember your SAMSUNG ACCOUNT DETAILS (usually an email address and password)

Once enabled, you can locate your device by going to <a href="https://www.google.com/android/find/">https://www.google.com/android/find/</a> and logging in to your Google account. You can then remotely locate, ring, lock, or wipe your device.

# How To Use "Find My" Application On iPhone (IOS)

- 1. Open **Settings** on your iPhone.
- 2. Tap on your **Apple ID** banner at the top of the Settings menu.
- 3. Navigate to iCloud.
- 4. Find "Find My iPhone" in the iCloud settings.
- 5. **Toggle the switch** next to "Find My iPhone" to the **ON** position.
- 6. Optionally, enable "Send Last Location" for added security.

Enter your Apple **ID password** if prompted to confirm the changes.

- The "Find My" application on the iPhone is just as helpful and can be used to track the whereabouts of a missing loved one.
- On both Android and IOS, ensure that you have the "find my network" or "find while offline" options activated.
  - This will ensure that even if a device runs out of power or something more sinister happens. The device can be tracked even while it is turned off.
- To prevent private data from being shared across devices during setup, it is recommended to create a neutral Google or Apple account on both devices to track one another.
  - This way, you can use your device as usual, and your information remains private, but if needed, your secure contact can track you in an emergency.
- Another important tip is to ensure you have a trusted family member's phone number or email address linked as a recovery contact on your Apple, Google, and Samsung accounts.
  - Doing this will increase your chances of being found when kidnapped as it will enable investigators like ourselves and law enforcement to utilize the chosen family member's accounts to access your location and other important information in an emergency.
- When set up correctly, any mobile phone can act as a lifesaving tool in an emergency, even if the device is turned off or broken.
